

Burns' Dogs' Day Out 2011

World's Biggest Dog Obedience Lesson

The record requires dogs and handlers to take part in a lesson lasting no less than 30 minutes during which the handlers will teach their dogs to respond to two new commands. The new commands taught will be for behaviours the dogs already know.

As well as having to comply with the governing bodies guidelines for this we want to make sure that it is as safe and enjoyable experience as possible. Although Lynne Davies from BBC's "Dog Borstal" will be leading the lesson, we will split the class into smaller groups so you get all the assistance you require. Each group will be looked after by a friendly, experienced trainer who will make sure you and your dog fully benefit from your participation. To be counted as a participant, you must remain within the arena and actively take part in the class for the whole lesson.

To participate you need to register at the Dogs' Day Out Show Office which will be next to the main arena. Alternatively, to save yourself a little time on the day, a copy of the form is attached so you can complete it in advance. When you register you will be given full instructions including which group you are in, who your group trainer is and whereabouts in the arena you will be. You will also be given two tickets which will be used to help verify your participation. One ticket will be collected as you enter the arena and the other as you leave so please do not lose them!

We hope to receive formal verification of the record within a month of the attempt. Once the record is confirmed we will email you with a password which will enable you to download a personalised, commemorative certificate for you and your dog. Alternatively you can have a certificate posted to you but there is a charge of £1.50 .

Important Notes

- Only one dog is permitted per handler
- Handlers under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
- All dogs must remain on lead at all times
