Privacy Notice

With your consent, We may also collect information such as clicks, mouse movements, hovers, scrolling, duration of visit, referral URL, navigation within the online store/website and device information (device type, browser type, operating system, language and screen resolution). This is statistical data about Our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual. It simply allows Us to monitor and improve Our service.

Data security
